

Age Champion calculations

Age Champion awards – 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals - are presented in each age group.

The Age Champion is the athlete who has performed both at a high level and consistently across the season.

The emphasis is on rewarding the *best all around athletes* in each age group. We use a point score to determine award winners, calculated using the following formula:

1. **Points for placing in each event contested** – 11 points through to 2 points from 1st to 10th, 1 point for placing 11th and over.
2. **Attendance points** – 1 point for each meet attended
3. **PB points** – 1 point for each PB achieved, recognizing improvement in performance
4. **Club records** – 20 points for beating a club record, 5 points for equaling a record.

This method rewards both high-level performances across *all* events and consistency, effort and attendance across the season. It includes ALL events on our program, including 1500m races and walks.

Club Champion

The Club Champion is the athlete who has the highest Points total of ALL athletes Under 7 and older at the Club across the season. They are presented with the Club Champion Shield and trophy.

Due to their modified program Under 6 athletes are not included in these calculations but are awarded Age Champion awards.
