IMPORTANT NOTE ON UNIFORMS FOR ACT CHAMPIONSHIPS

If you are planning on competing at ACT Championships, you **MUST** have a GUNLAC shirt or crop top with your Registration number, Age Patch and Coles sponsor patch.

Further - **all sponsor logos must be visible on your uniform** - this includes the sponsor logo on the age patch and the registration number. We are aware that some athletes's shirts and (in particular) crop tops have had these trimmed - you will not be allowed to compete without the logos on your shirt or crop top so these will need to be altered before ACT Championships. This is the directive we have received from Little Athletics ACT, recognising the value that sponsors which they receive from the funding they have provided to Little Athletics this season.
